



## COMMUNITY FEES AND FINES

Updated 10/05/2021

### REGISTRATION

A community will pay a registration fee of: \$300.00 for the first team and \$130.00 for each additional team.

**Example:** a community has 6 teams, 4 boys and 2 girls, the registration fee will be: 1 X \$300.00 plus 5 X \$130.00 = \$950.00 Total.

### OFFENSES AND FINES\*

MISSING A MEETING:	\$50.00
MISSING A DEADLINE: (Late for any date set by the Board (registration, roster, etc.))	\$50.00 per day
A registered team that withdraws their team before the end of the season. (Includes all teams withdrawn after season seeding has been submitted)	\$300.00
Withdrawal of teams after seeding has been submitted.	\$300.00
Allowing a player from another community to play without a waiver from both town Directors and the League Board or allowing a player to play in a league game that is not on the official team roster.	\$1,000.00
FORFEIT FEES: If a team does not show for a game, the game will be considered a forfeit. The community that caused the forfeit will pay a forfeit fee.	\$150.00
FORFEIT FEES: If a game is changed to another day/time from the original schedule after Wednesday of the week of the game, the game will be considered a game change and the community that caused the change must pay the fee before the next game.	\$150.00
FORFEIT FEES: If an official has to wait between games because the middle game has been cancelled or changed after Wednesday of the week of the game there will be a waiting charge. The community that caused the change must pay the fee before their next game.	\$150.00
REFEREE WAITING TIME: If a referee is scheduled to referee three games and the middle game is canceled and the home team cannot remove the gap in the schedule, the referee will be entitled to a fee for waiting	\$25.00

If an exigent circumstance arises causing the change or cancellation of a game, the possible rescheduling of the game must be brought to the attention of the League Board. The Board will determine any penalties and/or necessary payment to the officials.

All game changes must be approved by the League Board.

GAME EXPULSION: COACHES OR DIRECTORS

Suspended at least one game

SUSPENSION OR PROBATION:  
Of a Coach, Director or Community

\$100 - \$200

Failure to display current years I.D. Card. (Plus, cannot be on the sidelines.)

\$50.00

ROSTER: Failure to electronically submit final player roster to Registrar by calendar deadline for every team with all players listed, uniform numbers fully indicated, shared players marked with asterisks (fine per each missing roster)

\$25.00 per day  
per missing roster

## OFFICIALS FEES

We will always attempt to assign two officials to each game.  
The fees to the assigned officials are as follows.

**Please Note: Game fees are paid to the league at time of team registration for the entire season. In the case of forfeits, etc the team will be responsible for the additional game fees.**

- One Game – Two Certified Officials \$75.00 each official  
One Game - One Certified - One Junior \$85.00 Certified & Junior \$65.00
- One Game – One Official \$112.50 (\$56.25 from each team)
- 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Boys and 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Girls Officials Fees 2 Jr. Officials \$40.00 each or 1 Certified Official \$80
- Game called (not started) due to weather, safety or other unforeseen circumstances other than scheduling – If the officials are notified of the cancellation at least two (2) hours prior to the game there will be no fee paid. If an official(s) is/are on site and the game is cancelled prior to the start due to conditions listed above there will be a travel fee of \$40.00 paid to each official. If the game is a forfeit the official(s) will be paid a full fee from the community that forfeited.
- Game started and then canceled/interrupted. Full Fee (\$75.00 each official)
